### **Cadet Orders and Information**

- 1. Cadets must arrive on time to drill, in the proper uniform, within grooming standards, and with a valid ID card.
- 2. Cadets must arrive in PT uniform, but will be changing into Dress Whites later in the day for Annual Inspection
- 3. Cadets with Dress Whites already at the EOC must remember to bring a white crew neck t-shirt, black belt with silver belt buckle, white dixie cup cover and black sock, if not already at the EOC). Cadets must remember to wear white undergraments for when they change into Dress Whites.
- 4. Cadets who were not present at the last drill or who did not leave their Dress Whites at the EOC must remember to bring their Dress Whites and all components for the Annual Inspection.
- 5. Cadets will be provided an updated ribbon bar prior to Annual Inspection.
- 6. Cadets must bring a sea bag, dopp kitwhite binders, pen, hydration, and a bagged lunch.
- 7. Cadets can not bring sodas or energy drinks for lunch. Cadets are not permitted to skip lunch.
- 8. Cadets must follow the Acknowledgment and Absence policies. Cadets unable to attend drill must submit an Absence Form: <a href="https://www.staugustineseacadets.org/absentee-form">https://www.staugustineseacadets.org/absentee-form</a>.
